## Biography

Süleyman Saim Tekcan was born in Trabzon in 1940. He graduated from the Ankara Gazi Education Institute, Department of Painting in 1961. Between 1961-1962 he taught painting at the Artvin Teachers' School and between 1964-65, served as an Assistant Principal at the Işık High School. In 1964, he entered a competition organized by Ses Magazine and won second place and met Metin Erksan. In 1965, he performed in a role in Metin Erksan's film, "Time to Love". Between 1968-1975 he worked as an instructor at he Atatürk Training Faculty. Between 1970-71 he researched printmaking training in Germany. He first established his own printmaking studio in 1973. This studio later flourished and evolved at Söğütlücesme and Camlıca and hosted many Turkish artists. 1975 was a significant year in his life, both as an educator and as an artist. In 1975-1976, he held his first individual exhibits in Izmir and Istanbul. In 1975 he began his tenure as an instructor at the Mimar Sinan University School of Fine Arts and completed his Proficiency in Art Training. He earned the title of Professor in 1985 and was appointed as the Chairman of the Department of Graphic Arts the same year. In 1987 he taught his own serigraphy technique for two months at the Sarajevo Academy of Art in Yugoslavia. In 1991, he conducted seminar on printmaking at Bilkent University in Ankara. Also, in 1991, he held two conferences in Bonn, Germany, entitled, "12 Artists in Turkish Graphic Arts and A Segment From Contemporary Turkish Painting". From 1994-95 he served as dean at Mimar Sinan University while at the same time serving as Chairman of the Graphic Arts Department. In 1996, he established the Fine Arts Faculty of Yeditepe University, which started offering training at Büyükada in 1996 and served as the founding dean throughout its first year. In 2004, he established IMOGA, the Istanbul Museum of Graphic Arts. His service as dean of the Işık University School of Fine Arts, which he established in 2007, continued for 4 years. In 2008, he served as Chairman of the 1st International Original Printmaking Biennale, which was organized through the cooperation of IMOGA and Işık University.

While leading the production of artists at the printmaking studio of IMOGA, Istanbul Museum of Graphic Arts he also continues his own work at his studio here.
